NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY (NOFA) REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) APPLICATIONS

For The City Of Las Cruces Program Year 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME)

The City of Las Cruces (City) is announcing the start of the application cycles for Program Year (PY) 2017 CDBG and HOME programs. These Federally-funded programs are used by the City to provide decent housing, a suitable living environment, and the expansion of economic opportunities principally for persons and families with low incomes.

The City anticipates receiving the following grant amounts from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for PY 2017: CDBG \$773,000 and HOME \$309,000.

For an activity or project to receive consideration for application, a **RFP Letter of Intent (LOI) must be completed** by the non-profit organization or sponsoring agency and submitted to the Community Development Department, Neighborhood Services section.

(including CDBG-PUBLIC SERVICES) is 4:30 p.m. on
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2016.**

CDBG and HOME applications will only be accepted from eligible 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations, government entities, and qualifying grantees who submit an eligible RFP LOI. The City is required to prepare and submit to HUD a One-Year Action Plan that provides detailed information on all the activities that the City will fund with CDBG and HOME funds for PY 2017. The City will conduct a public hearing on the proposed One-Year Action Plan during March 2017. City Council will approve the final One-Year Action Plan in May 2017.
