Become a better driver by obeying all traffic signs and lights, stop to let pedestrians cross, walk when they can and turn their car into a 'mobile speed bump'. (One that gets out of the way of emergency vehicles!). When enough people join, traffic is effectively calmed city-wide. Pace Cars calm drivers rather than streets.
